Friedland has painted, taught, and exhibited extensively throughout the U.S., as well as Mexico, France, Italy, England, Spain, Portugal, Croatia, and China. During the pandemic, he, and his wife artist Susan Blackwood OPA began offering on-line classes from their home in Bella Vista, Arkansas.

“Aside from a paintings subject matter, a strong composition is essential to holding the viewer’s attention. As artists, we want to engage our audience in our work in a profound way. The viewer may not know exactly why they are attracted to a particular painting, but they are unmistakably drawn to it.”

Born in The Bronx, Howard Friedland OPAM studied fine art and commercial art at New York’s High School of Music and Art. He went on to attend the highly competitive Cooper Union for Advancement of Art and Science in New York City.

He has won many top awards including the prestigious Gold Medal award at OPA’s 17<sup>th</sup> Annual National Exhibition. Recently, Friedland was awarded the BoldBrush Award in the May, 2020 Boldbrush Painting Competition.
